- Celebrating our 5th Year! The Whaling City Catholic Community 2025 Harvest Craft Fair will take place in the handicap accessible Holy Name Parish Center at 121 Mt. Pleasant St., New Bedford, Mass. on Saturday, October 18th from 9:00 a.m. until 6:00 p.m. and Sunday, October 19th from 8:00 a.m. until 1:00 p.m.
- There are 30 indoor booths, 9½ feet wide by 8 feet deep (includes one 96" by 30" table with 2 chairs) or you can bring your own setup. Limited electricity along one wall only.
- 10+ outdoor booths available in the parking lot immediately to the rear of the Parish Hall, 10' by 10'. No electricity and your own setup, pop-up or tables.
- The Craft Fair retains the right to limit vendors selling some manufactured goods and we do not accept food vendors or food trucks - but candy/cookies/favors are permitted.
- The cost of either indoor or outdoor booth is \$50.00 for the two days. Sorry - no single day options.
- Reservations can be made by check or MO made out to **Holy Name Parish** and mailed directly to the 2025 Coordinator, Mike McCormack, 16 Briarwood Drive, New Bedford, MA 02745 or VENMO @WCCHCF or drop off an application w/ cash, check or M.O., at the Church Office (Mon., Tue. or Fri.)
- Each booth must also complete a *Fall River Diocese Adult Hold Harmless/Indemnity Agreement*.
- Indoor load-in is Friday, Oct. 17 from 3:00 to 6:00 p.m. and outdoor/indoor on Saturday, Oct. 18 from 7:00 to 9:00 a.m. Doors open for the public at 9:00 a.m. on Saturday and 8:00 a.m. Sunday.
